However, "Immune Mediated Neurological Disorders" was written as "IMMUNE-MEDIATED ABNORMALITIES". Please standardize the terms. 2. In introduction, "Jacobs-Creuzfeldt (JC)-virus" is considered as "John Cunningham virus". It was also recognized in the part of SIDE EFFECTS OF MEDICATIONS BIOLOGICS Progressive Multifocal Encephalopathy. 3. In the paragraph of "SIDE EFFECTS OF MEDICATIONS BIOLOGICS Infections of the Nervous System Meningococcal Meningoencephalitis Listeria Infection", authors mentioned the importance that patients receiving anti-TNF therapies observe safe food practices and refrain from the above mentioned food products. However, some races have a habit of eat raw food. Please show the accurate risks of eating these foods. Do authors consider that patients treated with anti-TNF alpha should not eat these foods definitely, or not? 4. In the paragraph of "SIDE EFFECTS OF MEDICATIONS BIOLOGICS Infections of the Nervous System Cerebral tuberculosis", the authors need to mention about the method to prevent tuberculosis infection before and after anti-TNF alpha therapy. 5. Please check spelling mistakes. Many mistakes were recognized such as RMI(MRI), TNF Alpha(TNF-Alpha), Adalimumab(Adalimumab), sulphasalazine (Sulfasalazine), Diabetes Mellytus(Mellitus) and so on. 6. Please re-check references by following the rules of "instructions to author".

However, it needs a great deal of language polishing. - Do not capitalize names of generic drugs - Review for spelling errors - they are numerous. - Would go into a bit more detail on JC virus test and risk of PML. - More clear separation of IBD induced and medication induced neurologic symptoms. - Shorten section on infections. Would discuss as separate category as side effect of immunosuppressive medications including steroids and AZA. Then cut section on AZA. - Would start with neurologic complications of IBD, not medicines.
