In my opinion it is a very good revision of this pathology, that could be improved with some minor changes: 1) The prevalence of the different etiologies (percentage) should be added in order to clarify the diagnostic algorithm 2) Minor language polishing: Crohn's disease should be abbreviated as CD; Separate CMV infection in infectious causes. 3) The references have to be ordered with numbers
