COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Cytomegalovirus (CMV) is the single most devastating viral infection causing morbidity and mortality in liver transplant patients. Prevention and treatment of CMV infection and disease has evolved over the years. The Authors describe the topic and review prevention and pre-emptive strategies. They offer a well-researched, complete study that does not add much new to the topic, but that can be useful nonetheless. There are several imprecisions and some language or grammar mistakes that need fixing, such as: - page 4, line 1: "is" is redundant. - page 5, line 11: "the" needs to be inserted before "highest" - page 8, line 1: "were" instead of "are" - page 8, line 5: eliminate the second "to" in the phrase "to which assays can be calibrated to" - page 10, line 15: change "that" with "the" when referred to "initial 3-6 months" - page 17, line 15: "there is some data" is incorrect. The verb must be plural ("are") All considered, if the Journal is interested in publishing a general review on CMV in Liver Transplantation, once the grammar and minor style imprecisions are fixed, the manuscript could be accepted.
