Please double check the English writing. 2.Introduction: There are some sentences in the introduction is not referenced. For example: "However, since its discovery, H. pylori has been associated with other disorders outside of the GI tract including diseases in hematologic, cardiovascular, neurologic, and dermatologic systems". Please provide some references. 3.IRON DEFICIENCY ANEMIA: The last 1st paragraph in page 4 and paragraph in page 5, "This is supported clinically by current guidelines such as the British..... (grade C). Additionally, the recent Maastricht IV....(grade A). The "grade C" and "grade A" need to write more detail to explain these sentences. 4.PARKINSONS DISEASE: The 1st and 2nd paragraphs in page 9, The English sentence writing of this section is confusing. Please double check the English writing. 5.Please double check the English writing and references. There were reference format errors in the manuscript.

COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

I think, this is a well written and clear review that focuses on the extraintestinal manifestations of H.pylori infection. However, I have some objectives. The authors tried to establish the link between chronic H.pylori infection and other diseases such as iron deficiency anemia, immune thrombocytopenic purpura, coronary artery disease, ischemic stroke, parkinsons diseases, Alzheimer diseases and chronic spontaneous urticaria. However, some other important diseases which may have a link between chronic H.pylori infection such as insulin resistance, metabolic syndrome, type 2 diabetes mellitus, fibromyalgia and chronic headache has not been mentioned in the manuscript. Also, it could be more pertinent to classify the diseases according to systems such as cardiovascular, neurologic, dermatologic and rheumatologic manifestations. I think this will make the review more systematic, hence more suitable for understanding. After the above mentioned modifications, this manuscript can be reconsidered for publication.
