The grammar and spelling need attention. It is not clear what is meant by g/die? Is that day? The paper lacks adequate referencing. In this statement "There are conflicting reports about the effects of alcohol on serum HCV-RNA. Some Authors have suggested that chronic ethanol consumption leads to a higher viral load; whereas the others have not found a relationship between HCV-RNA and the alcohol intake." no citations are provided. What is meant by recurrence of disease? Alcoholism?
