**COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

This is a case report of amenorrhea as a rare adverse event associated with everolimus treatment for advanced pancreatic NET. The manuscript is interesting, is well and clearly treated, and references are exhaustive. However, I think the Authors should amend some points: 1. There are some trivial errors. For instance: Introduction - Lines 8 and 9 "amenorea". 2. INTRODUCTION. "The drug related adverse events associated with everolimus were stomatitis, ..... or infections". The Authors should quote a reference. 3. The figures 2 and 5 are useless. I think the Authors should eliminate them.
