The manuscript entitled "Ciliated Hepatic Foregut Cyst: A rare benign lesion with extremely high intracystic CA19-9 level" is a description of a clinical case of a very rare entity. The subject is interesting and it may be useful for readers of WJG. The grammatical form and English in text are good. I have some recommendations to authors The numeration of figures calling in the text is no correct. Figure 4 and 5 do not correspond to description in the text. Units of micrograms are not correctly abbreviated. It seems to me that there are too many figures. I recommend preserving only 4 or 5 The manuscript may be shortening. I recommend not repeating concepts already discussed in the text.
