Thank you for the opportunity of reviewing this interesting manuscript. It is a systematic review of emergent laparoscopic colorectal surgery for benign and malignant disease. It is a well written and informative review. The subject matter is of high interest and is timely. It provides state of the art information on the subject. However there are no randomized trials available and majority of the studies included are case matched series or comparative studies and the results are variable between the series consequently the level of evidence is poor. Comments: 1. It should be interesting to know the selection criteria adopted in the different series to candidate the patients for a laparoscopic approach in emergency conditions. 2. At page 4 in the bottom the number of laparoscopic cases presented by Nash doesn't correspond to the number reported in the table 1.
