Thank you for the opportunity to review the manuscript, Colonoscopy Procedural Skills and Training for Primary Care Physicians. The increased demand for colonoscopy in Korea has increased the numbers of colonoscopies performed by primary care physicians. In this paper, the authors describe the basic principles and techniques to enable general practitioners to practice colonoscopy. It is unclear why this paper has been submitted to a gastroenterology journal as the target audience is primary care physicians. Furthermore, colonoscopy is best taught in a clinical environment under the supervision of an experienced colonoscopist.
