Nevertheless the manuscript has some editorial deficiencies: There is no abstract. Abbreviations are not defined in the text which confounds the reader. The reference callings are written in the text which is not in agreement with the instructions for authors of the journal. There are many orthographic mistakes. There are too many figures. In my opinion authors can keep 3 of them. Discussion is too large. It may be shortened.
