COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors described here a rare case of hepatic carcinosarcoma, which revealed typical features of CEUS. However, I have several minor comments to this article. 1. First line of Discussion section: Carcinosarcoma is a miscellaneous tumor. (according to WHO classification ?) 2. Page 5, 5th line: T1 and T2 -weighted images are features of MRI. Please refer the reference article for correct citation. 3. Page 5, "Hong-qiong Deng[15] "..., please add "et al" after the first author. 4. In the 4th paragraph of page 5, please add citations to CEUS features of FNH, hemangioma and HCC. Especially, I would encourage you to make a table to compare CEUS features of this case and other hepatic tumors in the literature.
