COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a well written case report concerning a diagnosis and possibility of surgical resection of gastric subepithelial lesion of the stomach presenting as an acute gastric abscess by a 45-year-old male patient. The authors present very detailed description of case history, all clinical, morphological and instrumental examinations performed for precise diagnose of a rare case of gastric abscess. The authors succeeded in well done diagnosis as well as in successful treatment of subepithelial lesion of the stomach using together with endoscopic drainage and antibiotics also surgical resection. The description of this case is very well illustrated by 4 high quality Figures and the authors have summarized review of case reports done in the literature in one Table. The possible pathogenic mechanism of gastric abscess is well discussed. This very rare case report expand the practical experience of early diagnosis of the gastric abscess and pay attention on the possibility of it successful treatment and make contribution for practical gastroenterology and surgery. I have noticed only one misprint in the "Abstract", line 4 in the word "supethelial". It should be "subepithelial".
