COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors have described a case of 16-year-old male patient with ulcerative colitis accompanied with severe inflammatory polyposis. This case is particular because of the early onset of disease and the severity of polyposis. Major points: 1. The time points of the treatment were not clearly stated. For example, in the context, "A second colonoscopy was performed 6 months later.....". Also, the authors did not mention the time point of colectomy and ileal pouch anal anastomosis (IPAA) surgery. 2. Some statements are ambiguous. For example, in the context, "The quality of life of the boy were normal." (This sentence contains grammar error actually) 3. The quality of writing is poor and there are numerous grammar mistakes, which largely attenuate this manuscript.
