## COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In this Report an unusual case of pancreatic carcinoma with leptomeningeal carcinomatosis is described. Since the authors Report also Report the steps of diagnosis in These particular cases, this Report might be interesting for the Readers of this Journal. There are a few specific Points which should be addressed: Abstract, page 3, first para, 10th line: "... hese methods are often difficult do Diagnose ..." This phrase does not make any sense. Introduction, page 5, first line: "Pancreatic cancer is the fourth most common cause ...". It should read: "Pancreatic cancer is the fourth frequent cause ...". Case Report, page 6, first para, 13th line: Not "was very rare ..." but "is very rare". Discussion, last line: "... this requires ...", not ..."this require ...". Discussion of this manuscript could be shortened by 20 - 30 %. Fig. 1 and 2 are informative; Fig. 3 could be omitted.
