I propose the article for publication in WJG with minor revisions: 1) paragraph: "iron deficiency in celiac disease": epidemiological data are lacking 2) paragraph "Iron deficiency and hemolysis": the reference is lacking 3) in "other causes of microcytic anemia in celiac disease" the authors should be consider autoimmune gastritis and HP gastritis (see for example references Nenna R, JPGN 2012; Miceli E, Clin Gastroenterol Hepatol 2012
