This manuscript describes regulatory T cell and inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). The content is very timely and interesting. However, a few points should be added before publication. 1. It is a recent topic that intestinal bacteria flow is associated with the onset or progression of IBD. The authors should describe content about regulatory T cell and bacterial flow. 2. It is reported that IL6 suppresses a differentiation of na[?]ve T cells to regulatory T cells and promotes the differentiation to Th17 cells. The authors should describe this content with some references. 3. Both in vivo and in vitro should be described as italic. 4. In page 6 lines 7, slash before accounts should be deleted.
