1. The article is titled as 'Future directions in inflammatory bowel disease. What is next?' however, the article reports in details the current therapeutic research performed for IBD treatment. The title maybe changed accordingly.
2. The article describes in details a lot of clinical trials without concluding the outcome of the trial and how it is helping in shaping the current directions in IBD treatment.
- Also, how can we optimize drug treatment for IBD patients with different severity and duration of the disease, in theory or practice?
- Are the treatments acting on tissue repair mechanisms as well inflammatory process?
- Changes in gut microbiota may not be the only factor in the initiation or the perpetuation of IBD but it should be evoked and discussed in the context of fecal microbiota transplantation as a potential therapy.
3. The symbols need to be checked all through the manuscript (Pg2 line 29 etc).
4. Spellings and spaces need to be checked all over the manuscript (Pg2 line 12, Pg 3 line 6,13, etc.).
5. Certain sentences need references (Pg14 line 19).
6. Pg11 line 12, is it an ongoing work or published research. If published please provide reference.
7. Pg 12 line 26, check figure title and describe

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Figure 3 needs a heading 9. Table 6 needs a heading and description. 10. Pg25 line 26, check font.
11. Pg 29 line 8, please explain Mayo scores. 12. Pg 33 line 29, check. 13. Pg 35 line 19, explain.
