The authors reported an interesting case of that developed AIH/PBC after LT. In discussion, 2. and 3. paragraphs can be combined according to following suggestions. The term "overlap syndrome" was first used in 1970s to describe variant forms of AIH which presented with characteristics of AIH and PBC or PSC [9,10,11], although there was no common definition or uniformly accepted diagnostic criteria for this at that time" should be initial sentence of previous paragraph "Table-4 and related ones(details of diagnostic criteria) are not really necessary while it is available everywhere. it is enough to define criteria by Chazouillères et al or Paris criteria. Regarding therapy of these patients please include recent large study of AIH/PBC(Ozaslan E,Clin Gastroenterol Hepatol. 2014 May;12(5):863-9. doi: 10.1016/j.cgh.2013.09.021.) authors should include a few words for conclusion.
