COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

It is an interesting study with regard to adjuvant therapy in gastric cancer patients. Nevertheless, minor revisions are implemented. 1. In the text under Introduction, the First paragraph should be reduced dramatically. Epidemiological data refering to Europe and USA should only be retained. The first two paragraphs should be only one. In the rest of the section clinical trials as well as meta-analyses and studies should not be analysed. Therefore, the Introduction should be reduced. 2. The aim of the study should be defined at the end of Introduction. 3. Sections refering to prognostic factors should be analysed before indications for adjuvant therapy. 4. Clinical trials should be mentioned at the end of the manuscript. 5. Grammatical errors should be corrected. 5. Older publications should be excluded.
