## COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a nicely-written review of the role of conventional gray-scale ultrasound, Doppler ultrasound and CEUS for early diagnosis of vascular complications after adult LDLT. I have the following comments: 1. There is a problem with the punctuation especially in the Introduction e.g. (;) should be replaced by full stop (.). 2. It is worth including some illustrative figures of US findings in various vascular complications of LRLT 3. What are the false positive and false negative rates of Doppler US in detecting HAT? 4. Page 5, paragraph 2: Correct grammar mistake "... which may result in reduce use of angiography ." 5. Page 6, under HAS: Change (anastomosis stoma) to anastomotic site). 6. Page 8, under PVT: Correct grammar mistake "PVT may be lead to liver function". 7. Page 10, paragraph 2: change "the drainage areas" to "the drained area".
