Regarding submission "Low-Grade Slightly Elevated and Polypoid Colorectal Adenomas Display Differential β -Catenin-TCF/LEF Activity, c-Myc, and Cyclin D1 Expression", number 30112: The article has academic and public interest. It could show some new signaling pathway to development of distinct polyps. It has clinical interest as well, because of the distinct risk of cancer into different polyps types, with or without needed of resection to colonoscopy and clinical follow up. We have a few suggestions: 1. To review the English Language, some changes are needed: "To this end" ("To this purpose?"); "to comparatively investigate" ("to compare"?), etc; 2. The results chapter is too long. The graphical and supplementary material are enough to understand the results. I suggest suppressing or decreasing the written text; 3. The results are insufficient for the conclusion. When the author pointed to the study limitations, he observed it. I suggest including correlation test (Pearson, Spearman) to increase the power of the observations and the associations cited throughout the text; 4. Figure 5: Increase the quality.
