This article report a rare case of Pancreatic T/histiocyte-rich large B-cell lymphoma; a review of literature has been also discussed. The case report is important because it describes an uncommon clinical manifestation, however, some adjuncts should be made. The introduction is poor: please, describe other rare/uncommon manifestation of lymphoma (Please, see: Inchingolo F, Tatullo M, Abenavoli FM, Marrelli M, Inchingolo AD, Inchingolo AM, Dipalma G. Non-Hodgkin lymphoma affecting the tongue: unusual intra-oral location. Head Neck Oncol. 2011 Jan 4;3:1.). In the Discussion, authors correctly described the differential diagnosis between this rare pancreatic lymphoma and other pancreatic ones; however, since this case report should be useful to clinicians and surgeons, also a differential diagnosis should be discussed with other abdominal pathologies that could mimicking the signs of this one. Finally, it is correct the (brief) description of the different therapeutic approaches, however, it is important to briefly report also the most innovative researches on the oncological therapies (Please, see:
