COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an excellent study about the efficacy and safety of stellate ganglion block on chronic ulcerative colitis. In this study, the authors investigated the efficacy and safety of stellate ganglion block in the treatment of patients with chronic ulcerative colitis. A total of 120 randomly selected patients with chronic ulcerative colitis were included into this study. Patients were divided into two groups: control group and experimental group. After treatment, clinical symptoms and disease activity under endoscopy were found to be both alleviated in the control group and experimental group; but abdominal pain relief was not obvious in the control group. The stellate ganglion block technique can effectively improve the treatment efficiency of chronic ulcerative colitis, relieve the clinical symptoms of patients, and reduce the level of inflammatory factors.
