Interesting study about the quantitative assessment of hepatic fibrosis in chronic hepatitis B and C. In this study, 109 patients with chronic hepatitis B were included. About 73 patients had both pathological results and MRI information. HeF by EOB enhancement imaging was significantly correlated with fibrosis stage. The authors found that a T1 mapping-based HeF method is an efficient diagnostic tool for the staging of liver fibrosis. 1 The figures should be checked and edited. 2 References are well discussed. However, some more recent references should be included and discussed further.
