The manuscript aims to introduce the new version of consensus for the management of liver transplant patients with metabolic disease in China. The contents are all borrowings and rehash of literatures including figures and tables with no originalities. The contents are directed to Chinese domestic transplant doctors. In addition, the manuscript is prepared most carelessly; Abstract is not a summary of the contents but only history of Chinese consensus. Data in Introduction are cited without indicating references and world and domestic data are mixed. Thus, it is inappropriate to publish this sort of things in international scientific journal such as World Journal of Gastroenterology.

Good summary paper with specific recommendations for the Chinese audience. Can the authors explain the COMMIT group? My only minor comment is that recommendation IV for diabetes- to test for gene polymorphisms in donors and recipients- appears to lack a significant practical benefit. Minor grammatical changes needed.
