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The grammatical and ortographical errors throughout the manuscript were corrected. Please have a closer look regarding spacing between words throughout the paper. Ex: "Chronic HCV patients with paired liver biopsy before and after DAAs treatment were included. SVR was defined as an undetectable serum HCV RNA level at 24 wkafter treatment cessation. Ishak system and P-I-R score were assessed.Inflammation improvement and fibrosis regression were defined as ≥ 2 -points decrease in the HAI..." or "82%(31/38)ofpatients achieved inflammation". Maybe this is due to a different version of Microsoft Word, but its better to recheck.
