This comes in contrast with the line 87, were the blood test analysis on admission revealed Hb 9.7g/dL. Please explain. Was there a red blood transfusion in between? 2. Line 117: please explain why you used montelukast as a monotherapy to reach remission and/or not local corticosteroids, like budesonide? Best Regards
