Alcohol-related liver cirrhosis is an important clinical and social problem. A better understanding of its pathophysiological mechanisms can improve the effectiveness of diagnosis and treatment. Comments: 1. The authors processed the data with their own program using R. Is this program (script) deposited in some repository? If so, it is recommended that a link be added. 2. The description of the clinical data of the patients is not detailed enough. Did the patients in the healthy controls group have any medical conditions? Why were they admitted to the Liver Disease Center of Ditan Hospital? What medications were patients in the ALC group taking? Was the age of ALC diagnosis taken into account or were all patients with newly diagnosed disease? Did patients in both groups have other diseases, including colitis, pancreatitis, cholecystitis? 3. Since all the patients were men, should we remove the information in the "Study design and patients" section that refers only to women? 4 The authors conclude that individual metabolites are related to the severity of ALC. It is recommended to add clinical characteristics of ALC severity in the patients included in the study.
