## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a letter to the editor submitted with regard to the paper by Mocchegiani F et al. titled "Intraductal papillary neoplasm of the bile duct: The new frontier of biliary pathology" published in World J Gastroenterol. The letter is primarily a short review dealing with the topics of intraductal papillary neoplasms of the bile duct and pancreatic duct. While providing interesting and up-to-date content regarding the above mentioned topics, there are little or no comments of strengths or weaknesses of the paper by Mocchegiani F et al. This short review may merit publication in another journal or in this journal on another occasion, but its content is only partly related to the paper that it was suppose to provide comments on. The topic of IPMN of the pancreas reviewed in the letter is an entirely different area from IPN-BD and, therefore, I believe that this letter would not make an appropriate comment on the paper by Mocchegiani F et al. If the authors are ready to make a comprehensive revision of their letter, they should only focus on the IPN-BD and provide more insight and analysis with regard to the paper by Mocchegiani F et al.
