The manuscript "INSULIN AND LEPTIN AS COMPONENTS OF AUTONOMIC REGULATION OF BODY WEIGHT" by Dr. Borer provides an interesting perspective on the regulation of body weight by leptin and insulin. I have a few comments that the author may consider to improve the manuscript:

- The manuscript is rather comprehensive, as well as the number of citations. An abstract is certainly warranted, to help the reader to appreciate the major points discussed. Within acceptable limits, I believe the author should make an effort to shorten the main text and perhaps remove a selection of references which are not of primary importance.
- I found several typing mistakes within the manuscript. The manuscript would benefit of a careful proofreading.
- Similarly, references should be edited. For example, Epub dates for reference 2, 8, 9 and many others are useless, as the definitive version of these papers is appeared.

The review is about the interactions of insulin and leptin in the control of both meal-to-meal eating and eating in response to body weight. It is well prepared and written. Several minor concerns should be addressed. 1. Lack of abstract. 2. Is there a section 2a? 3. Figure 1-4 copy from other journals, are they approved to use in World Journal of Diabetes by Physiology & Behavior, J Clin Endocrinol Metab even if the data were from author's Lab? 4. Some abbreviations in text are defined several times (e.g. GI, BWT, DIT, and some abbreviations lack full words (e.g. PVN, PP, VTA). 5. Some words spelling mistakes, for example, ood and transsections (page 6), ananabolic, sulin and trigerring (page 12), Futher (page 18), Lectrical (page 21), mportant (page 22). 6. Insulin (IR) resistance (page 15) should be Insulin resistance (IR), Figure 7 (page 26) is figure 6
