The manuscript "Pancreas Transplantation: The Wake Forest Experience in the New Millennium" introduce to the public the pancreas transplantation happened in the Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center from 11/1/01 through 3/1/13. A total of 202 PTxs were performed in 192 patients, including 162 SKPT, 35 sequential PAK, and 5 PTA (40 SPTs), and the authors compared these cases on different parameters.
