Way too many errors and can be easily fixed by a simple spell-check and having someone read it again. 2. Can you comment on what would lead you to believe this is happening vs ileus from appendicitis or the level of pain/WBC, etc? Is it the degree of SBO (like Figure 1) that provides the major insight?
