It was a pleasure to read and its details and thoroughness promise to make it a well cited paper. I have no major issue at all. two very minor points to please amend: - Page 8 second paragraph first word should be "ischaemia". - Page 8 4th paragraph, "The clinical presentation of gallstone ileus is that of gastrointestinal obstruction" should be followed by "and" before the rest of the sentence.
