Dear authors, I would like to congratulate you with this fine study. However, I have few comments. INTRODUCTION -- I do not think you need to talk on TNT here - it is not the aim of your article. -- I would include here or in the DISCUSSION the review article on biomolecules as a prognostic factors - Smolskas E, Mikulskytė G, Sileika E, Suziedelis K, Dulskas A. Tissue-Based Markers as a Tool to Assess Response to Neoadjuvant Radiotherapy in Rectal Cancer-Systematic Review. Int J Mol Sci. 2022 May 27;23(11):6040. MATERIALS and METHODS -- It is not clear to me was is a retrospective study (last paragraph) or prospective (first paragraph)? -- Abbreviation NCCN should be defined. --Same with OS. --SPSS manufacturer, city should be included. --Score 1 - what are those "other situations"? RESULTS -- CRM definition --"didn't have" these kind of shortenings must be avoided. DISCUSSION --some mistype errors should be corrected (didn't, robustest, etc) --if the predictive value was weaker than pTNM, which is always known, what is the purpose of performing additional tests? I would suggest combining all the factors and preparing some nomogram for the precise prognosis. Major limitations: small single center retrospective study with the significant drop-off of the patients.
