SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Thank you for revising the manuscript according to my suggestion. The revised manuscript is improved. However, the following minor issues require clarification: 1. (P4L2-6) The "Patients and samples" section seems strange, which contains patients' characteristics. Those information should be described in the Results section. 2. Figure 5 may cause confusing for readers. The position of arrows should be located not from "Prognostic information" but between "Cancer" and "Prognostic information". Furthermore, the information regarding "Non-cancer" biopsy should not be described at the same figure. I recommend it is described only in the text.

Thank you for revising the manuscript according to my suggestion. The revised manuscript is much improved. However, a following minor issue remains unresolved: 1. Information regarding "non-cancer" biopsy (159 samples) should be described in the main text.
