The present manuscript describes the hereditary syndromes and chronic inflammatory disease association between synchronous gastric and colon cancers. There are some errors which should be revised. Question 1: The meaning of the title is not clear. Please revise it. Question 2: The manuscript only describes the independent content of hereditary syndromes and chronic inflammatory disease. However, the relations of both with synchronous gastric and colon cancers remain unclear, for example, the incidence, the mutation status of gene, the time to evolve cancer. In particular, the synchronous content of gastric and colon cancer is not clearly depicted.
