COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This review describes the tricks and tips of pancreatoduodenectomy with three parts: the initial approach to the superior mesenteric artery, arterial complications caused by anatomic variants of the hepatic artery or celiac artery stenosis, and the extent of lymphadenectomy. It narrated both the history, problems, and progress of pancreatoduodenectomy. Actually, this is a well written review almost without any revision. However, some minor revision should be carried out. First, the “??” may be a mistake in Reference 10. Second, the original language of Reference 21 and 28 is Spanish. But I think that references described with English may be better in an international journal.
