In the report important differential diagnoses of tumor at the ampulla are addressed and minimal invasive surgery is discussed as an important tool to omit overtreatment. Comments 1. The abortive duodenal cystic duplication and inflammatory pseudotumor should be addressed. 2. Figure 3 needs a better description. In particular, the pancreatic tissue should be marked in Figure 3C.
