Capsule endoscopy (CE) offers an enhanced diagnostic yield in the detection of small bowel colonic mucosal abnormalities. The aim of the presented paper was to review the role of video capsule endoscopy in the diagnosis and assessment of inflammatory bowel disease. This topic is highly up-to date and important not only for the capsule users but all physician dealing with patients with inflammatory diseases. This paper gives a comprehensive review about the available technology, indications, complications and clinical usefulness of wireless capsule technology both in the small and the large bowel. The paper is well-conducted and well-written, containing relevant and updated references. I would only like to raise one point for consideration: the disposition of paper should be changed, and the section of complication with all related topics should be moved to the end of the paper.
