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## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Cordier and colleagues tried to summarize the pathologist's point of view for the pediatric hepatic vascular tumors. The review is well written. The title reflects the main subject of the manuscript. The abstract reflects the work described in the manuscript. The presented figures are clear. However, there are some concerns. Major comments: The infantile hepatic hemangioendothelioma (IHHE) presented in many clinical studies in the literature was not clearly presented in the review with its synonymous terminology from the pathologist's point of view. Moreover, mentioning hepatic hemangioendothelioma type 1 in page 2, hemangioendothelioma type 2 in page 6, and hemangioendothelioma type 3 in page 10 is confusing and needs more clarification of its classification and synonymous lesions in different perspectives. Minor comments: Abbreviations: please spell out any used abbreviation on its first appearance. Example; page 4: spell out ERG. Referencing: - Page 2, under the title introduction: reference 1 is not the suitable one. Please report the 1997 reference which for the first time differentiated vascular tumors from malformations. - In 2014, the international ...... Correct citation into reference 1 only. - All references should be carefully rechecked Page 7: off type IV collagenase----of Please throughout the whole manuscript summarize the classification of presented hepatic vascular tumors presented in the review in either a table or a figure.
