There are several minor comments; -Can the authors mention little bit more about living donor liver transplantation? Due to organ shortage, especially in Asian countries, there are some cases, of course not many, of living donor liver transplantation in these benign liver tumor patients. -Can the authors update the references? Most of the references are before 2015. I understand that reports dealing with long-term outcomes inevitably are before 2015s, but still more recent references are required to increase the value of this paper.
