This is a compilation of many studies with a very large number of patients. It is very valuable. However, some details need to be clarified: 1. Is hypothyroidism a risk factor leading to NAFLD? Or does persistent NAFLD cause hypothyroidism? 2. Why doesn't thyroid hormone replacement therapy for hypothyroidism improve the risk of NAFLD? 3. The degree of hypothyroidism should be categorized. What degree is the risk factor for NAFLD? 4. How long does the treatment hypothyroidism take to reduce the risk of NAFLD effectively? 5. Each patient group should be analyzed such as obesity, T2DM, DLP, HTN. Which group of patients is more related to hypothyroidism?
