COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a well-written and exhaustive review concerning the extra-hepatic disorders induced by HCV, which testify the large experience of the Authors in the field. Only few remarks: Table 1: the association of chronic HCV infection with oral lichen planus, sialadenitis and arthritis is widely accepted since many years, as a consequence it cannot be still indicated as "possible". The production of several non-organ-specific auto-antibodies other than rheumatoid factor and cryoglobulins is increased in HCV patient, making difficult the differential diagnosis with many idiopathic autoimmune disorders. This topic should be briefly outlined. Typing errors are in the article (f.i. : Bechet's syndrome and psorias, in Table 1).
