SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is, in summary, an interesting study, aimed to evaluated the diagnostic performance of des-gamma-carboxy-prothrombin (DCP) in cases of hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC), in comparison with the commonly used biomarker, Alpha-fetoprotein (AFP). And it was found that, DCP maybe a good replacement of AFP, as the primary HCC biomarker, as DCP performed better than the latter in many categories. Therefore, I think it is a good scientific paper with a beneficial outcome. The paper is generally well-organized and well-written, but needs some language polishing, other than that, I have no further comments to the author/s.
