P15: "septum nto the right ventricle" "Surgical treatment can be be considered it there are associated complications or hemodynamic abnormalities." P17: "pulmonic vale" "Superior venacava Aneurysm"

Page 15, line 4 (Ventricular septal aneurysms, line 8) Correct "septum nto the right ventricle" to "septum into the right ventricle".
