-Title: typo errors (centre) -Abstract: Grammar revision is recommended -Introduction: 1- "A strong association was observed between the magnitude of antibody response and patient survival, disease severity and fatal outcomes" Kindly add a source (several sources can be added such as https://doi.org/10.3390/pathogens10050565). 2- In introduction section you mention that the total number of patients is 493, is it OK? -Methods: You should specify how did you get the serological (IgM IgG) results; Did you retrospectively retrieve the documented results (if so then you should mention in inclusion criteria that the patients only who had those results in the medical files) OR did you perform the serology tests in the stored serum samples? - Results: 1-In table 1 why do you record both mean and median in some values? 2- Some figures (eg, 5,6) could be replaced by table or tables to be more clear.
