Did the patient diagnose of small cell lung cancer or not when he was first admit for pancreatitis one month prior? If yes, why he did not run MRCP that time? If not, when was he diagnose of SCLN and how? 2. Did the patient with a condition of hypercalcaemia at the first administration? 3. Did the patient perform EUS-FNA? Why not apply it to drain the cystic to decrease the compression? 4. More information about paraneoplastic hypercalcemia should be discussed.
