The case report is structured such that giant cell tumor of bone dominates the



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introduction and discussion, despite the tumor ultimately being diagnosed as an ABC. ABCs are not rare tumors in patients under 20 years of age, and 12% of ABCs occur in the pelvis. The MRI images are of poor quality. Were there multiple fluid-fluid levels? The introduction and discussion should be re-written to better discuss the differential diagnosis of this lesions and the overlapping and differentiating features between GCT and ABC. More also needs to be written regarding the histopathological differentiation of these entities (which isn't always straightforward) and which special stains may help.
