• Reasonably comprehensive review of the literature regarding anterior glenohumeral instability • Summarizes existing findings well, although doesn't bring much else to the table • Although the authors go into detail discussing glenoid, humeral, and bipolar bone loss, the article proceeds to go ahead simply with describing arthroscopic soft tissue stabilization. It would be beneficial to discuss specifically the indications for arthroscopic bony Bankart repair in the greater context of anterior glenohumeral instability and what specific metrics or factors might drive a surgeon to consider bony reconstruction. • Minor missing hyphens and commas noted.
