Please correct it. Introduction It would be helpful if you could provide a brief explanation of why patients with CKD develop tumoral calcinosis, as you started discussing parathyroidectomy without mentioning its involvement. Material Do you believe that Bicanate specifically has the capacity to dissolve tumoral calcinosis? If not, and any bicarbonate Ringer's solution can be used, it is better not to mention the commercial name. Case presentation Abbreviations must be written in full the first time they appear in the text (e.g., Ca++). Very interesting case and I appreciate the technique used.
